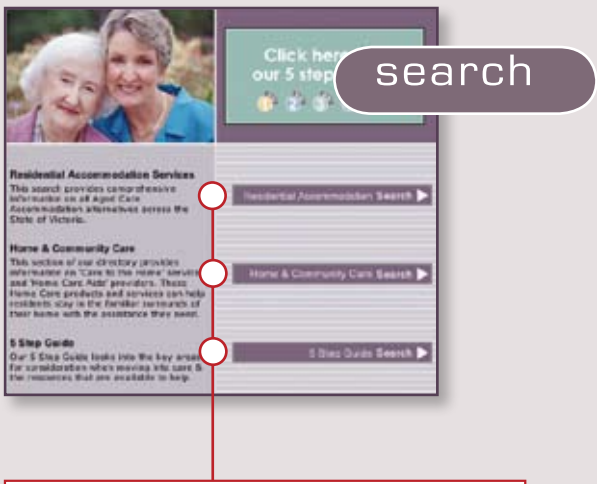

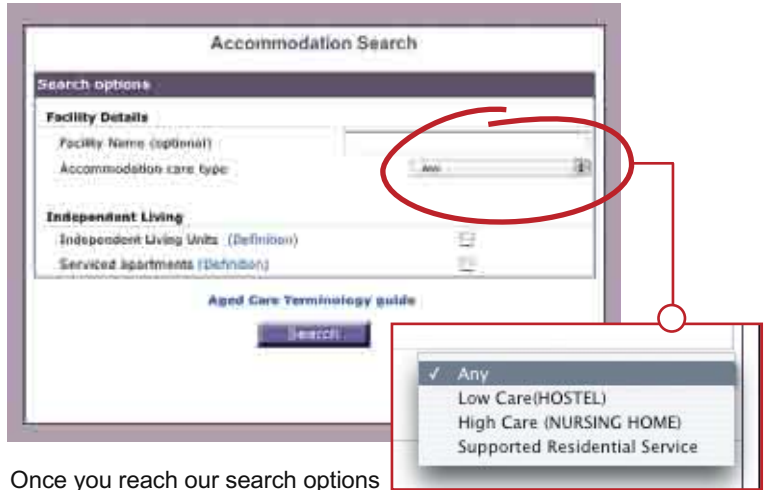

Once your search result comes through you can always further refine this list using the options found above the search return. Here you can select your suburb/town and also facilities that have permanent and respite vacancies.

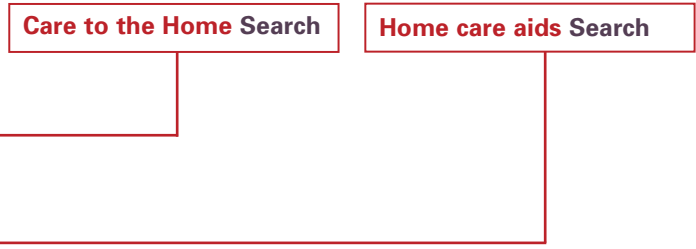

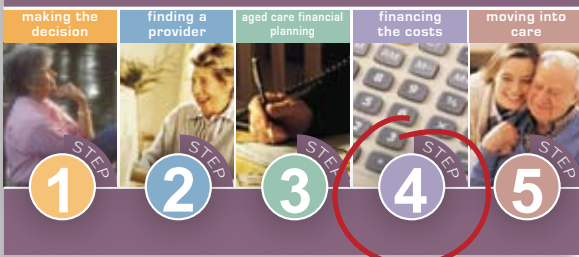

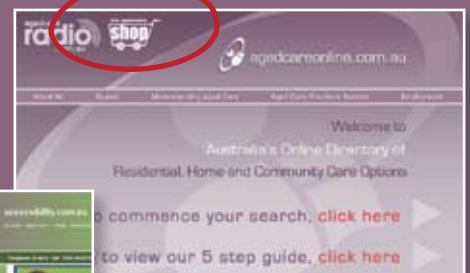
